## BAPTISMS:

Baptism is celebrated on the First and Third Saturdays of each month. Parents are required to complete the Baptism preparation program prior to scheduling the Baptism. An interview with the Parish Services Coordinator or one of the Parish Priests is necessary before beginning the Baptism sessions.

## MARRIAGES:

Archdiocesan Regulations require that notice of intended marriage be made six months prior to the date of the marriage. Pre-nuptial instructions are required for marriage. Contact the Rectory for location.

## CARE OF THE SICK:

Communion to the sick and Anointing of the Sick will be given upon request of someone who is ill, having surgery, or preparing for death. Emergency sick calls for the dying may be made at any time.

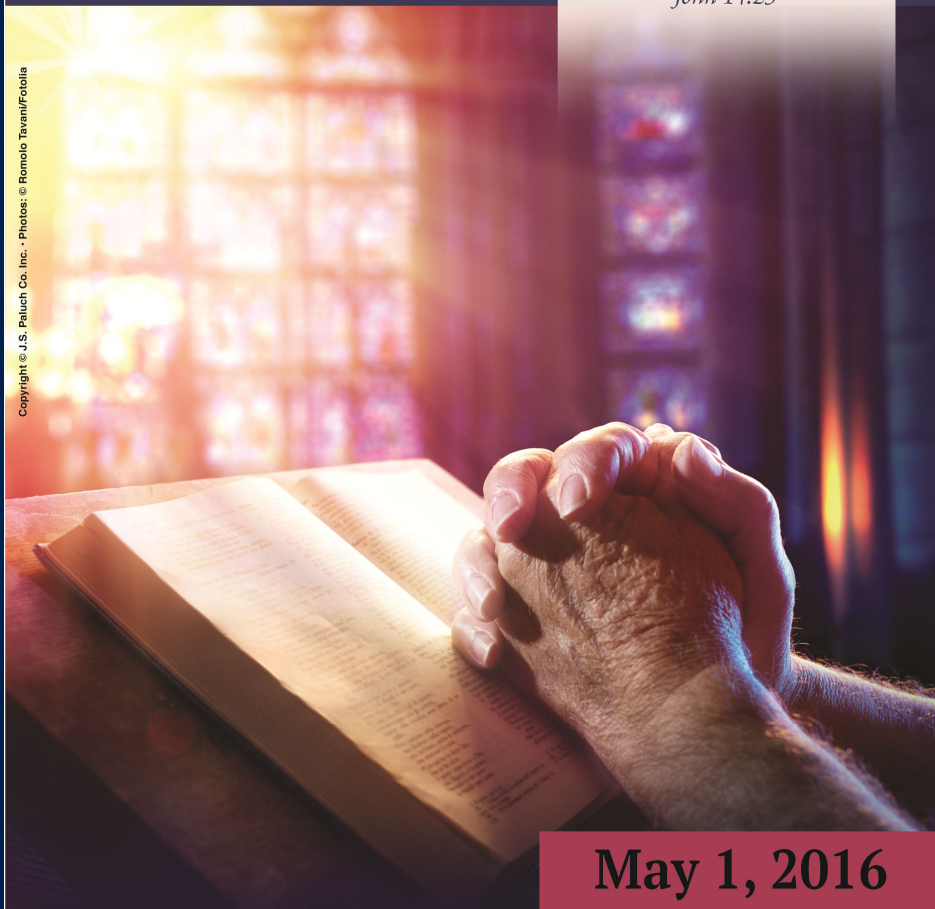

## CROSS-TRAIN YOUR FAITH

In Session Six we cover three periods on The Bible Timeline Chart: **Divided Kingdom, Exile, and Return.** Jeff Cavins explains the state of Israel after Solomon's death and how it divides into **two separate kingdoms**: ten tribes to the North secede and become a new kingdom, still called Israel, and ruled from Samaria; two tribes to the South remain loyal to David's successor and become the kingdom of Judah with a capital in Jerusalem. Punishment comes in the form of **exile**. Israel falls to Assyria and its people are deported to the countries to the north. Judah hangs on longer, but the people are marched into Babylonian exile in 587 B.C. Jerusalem and the temple are destroyed. The period ends with all that is left of the "old" kingdom of Israel – the tribe of Judah – enduring seventy years of captivity in Babylon.

In the period of the **Return** the exiles from Judah return to the Promised Land, chastened and ready to rebuild their land and their lives. Jeff Cavins explains how the Return occurs in three waves. Obstacles to rebuilding will be covered, along with the means God uses to help his people triumph.

**"Cross Train Your Faith"** is part of the Adult Faith Formation Program here at Queen where we provide programs of study and present information of Catholic learning for the adults of Our Parish Family. All adults are invited to join us. There is no charge to participate, except if you want to purchase special study material available.

## THE YEAR OF MERCY

**The Jubilee Year of Mercy**  
**December 8, 2015 through November 20, 2016**

### The Holy Spirit, Fountain of Mercy

Mercy lies at the heart of the Christian faith. Catholics believe in a God of Mercy. He manifested His Mercy, first and foremost, in the Incarnation of his Word in the Person of Jesus Christ, who died on the cross for our sins. When he walked this earth, Jesus lived for others and greeted everyone he met with mercy and compassion. Mercy was the reason he entered this world. Mercy was why he forgave sins. Mercy was why he cured people of their physical ailments. Mercy was why he cast out demons. Mercy was why he suffered and died for us. Mercy for others was what he asked of his Father from the cross. Mercy was what flowed from his pierced side in the form of blood and water. Mercy was why he sent his Spirit to dwell in the hearts of the members of his body, the Church. Mercy was the reason for the sending of his Spirit at Pentecost.

The Holy Spirit is the Fountain of Mercy. He is the soul of the Church, the sacrament of Christ. He is invoked at the celebration of every sacrament. He is the source of Mercy, because he is the Bond of Love shared by the Father and the Son. From that Bond everything else flows: Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist, Reconciliation, Orders, Matrimony, Anointing. These sacraments give honor and glory to the Father. They are actions of Christ. They are the works of the Spirit. Through them we receive his manifold gifts and fruits. Holy Spirit, Fountain of Mercy, pray for us. – Rev. Dennis J. ### **How to Live It**

During the Holy Year of Mercy, begin the practice of invoking the Holy Spirit as soon as you wake up in the morning. Use the *Veni, Sancte Spiritus* or similar prayer to the Holy Spirit. Take note of the special daily mercies that result from this simple act of dependence on the Third Person of the Trinity.

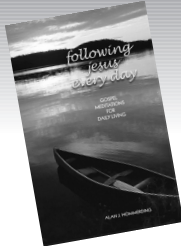
