MOVING:

If you are moving out of the parish, please notify the Rectory immediately so that we may discontinue your envelope mailings.

BAPTISMS:

Baptism is celebrated on the First and Third Saturdays of each month. Parents are required to complete the Baptism preparation program prior to scheduling the Baptism. An interview with the Parish Services Coordinator or one of the Parish Priests is necessary before beginning the Baptism sessions.

MARRIAGES:

Archdiocesan Regulations require that notice of intended marriage be made six months prior to the date of the marriage. Pre-nuptial instructions are required for marriage. Contact the Rectory for location.

CARE OF THE SICK:

Communion to the sick and Anointing of the Sick will be given upon request of someone who is ill, having surgery, or preparing for death. Emergency sick calls for the dying may be made at any time.

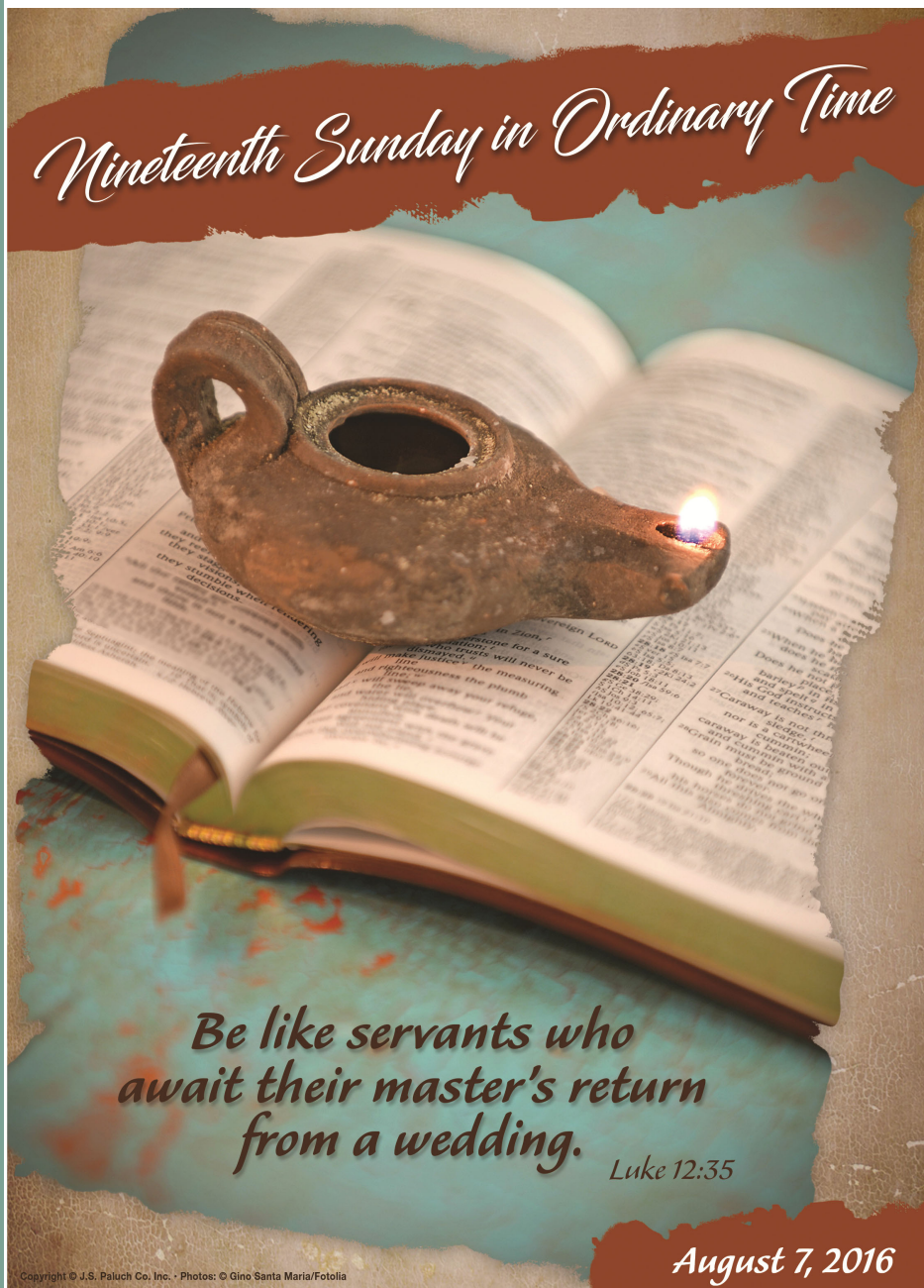

YOUR FIRST SMALL STEP TO BECOMING CATHOLIC

There are many stories out there about men or women who for one reason or another, never completed their faith journey after Baptism and later in life came to the rectory asking to become a part of RCIA session leading to full initiation into the Catholic Church.

A few years ago a woman called to say she had been married for 30 years. She was baptized in a Protestant church and married her husband in a Catholic Church. Her children went to Queen of the Universe School. She attended Mass every Sunday and Holyday with her husband.

Then one Sunday, while her husband was coming back from receiving Holy Communion, she thought. "Why am I sitting in this seat and my husband is coming back from Holy Communion. " I will call the rectory Monday to find out how I can become a Catholic after all these years.

One phone call to Queen's rectory, on Monday morning, was all she needed. She was registered for the RCIA session that was beginning in September and was received into the Catholic Church at the Vigil Mass on Holy Saturday the following Easter. She was required to provide a copy of her Baptism Certificate and her Marriage Certificate.

The Holy Spirit was very active in our RCIA group for 2015-16. There were 12 men and women seeking to become Catholic. Some required marriage convalidations, some were baptized and never catechized, some never received Confirmation.

Call the rectory to speak with Fr. Mike or Fr. John. You can then register and your name will be given to the RCIA team for followup.

RCIA sessions begin on Thursday, September 15, at 7:00 PM in the Parish Center, Room #3 on the first floor.

Cross Train Your Faith

Did you know that Pope Francis has given Mary Magdalene a canonical rank equivalent to that of the apostles?

Without a doubt, the most important woman in human history was Mary, the Mother of God. No other human has ever been so richly honored as she who bore God in her own flesh.

Who the second-most-important woman is in history is more debatable, but a strong case could be made for St. Mary Magdalene. On June 3 of this year a new decree bumped the liturgical celebration honoring St. Mary Magdalene from a memorial to a feast, putting her on par with the apostles. Her memorial has been celebrated on July 22, which will now be her feast day.

According to Archbishop Arthur Roche, secretary of the Vatican's Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments, the reason is that she "has the honor to be the first witness of the Lord's resurrection."

On the Church's liturgical calendar, saints are honored with either a "memorial" a "feast," or a "solemnity." Solemnities rank the highest, with feasts coming in second and memorials in third.

For example, when Mass is celebrated on her feast day, rather than using the normal formula for a daily Mass, as is done with memorials, the Gloria will be sung and special prayers dedicated specifically to Mary Magdalene will be offered, which only happens on feasts and solemnities.

While opinions vary on just exactly who she was, Archbishop Roche said that "what is certain is that Mary Magdalene was part of the group of Jesus' disciples, she accompanied him to the foot of the Cross and, in the garden where she met him at the tomb, was the first witness of Divine Mercy."

He said Pope Francis' decision to elevate her memorial to a feast during the Jubilee of Mercy, was done in order to emphasize the importance of this woman, "who so loved Christ and was so greatly loved by Christ."

Noting how Mary Magdalene was the first eyewitness to the Risen Christ and the first to announce his resurrection to the apostles, Archbishop Roche hailed her as "the Apostle to the Apostles" – a phrase coined by St. Thomas Aquinas.

St. Mary Magdalene, the archbishop said, "announces to the apostles what in turn they will announce to the whole world."

Think about the beautiful parallels in the life of Jesus. Both at his birth and at his resurrection (rebirth), Jesus' first moments were shared with a woman named Mary.

The Corporal Works of Mercy

Jesus was a Person of **action** who showed mercy and compassion in concrete ways. Jesus fed the hungry, sheltered those in need, visited the sick and buried the dead.

Jesus took time and paid close attention to recognize the basic needs of the persons He encountered. He challenges us to do the same. The Catechism teaches that "human misery elicited the compassion of Christ the Savior. Hence, those who are oppressed by poverty are the object of a preferential love on the part of the Church" (2448).

The Corporal Works of Mercy are a roadmap for each of us to share in Jesus' ministry. As St. Teresa of Avila reminds us: "Christ has no body now on earth but yours, no hands but yours, no feet but yours. Yours are the eyes through which to look out Christ's compassion to the world. Yours are the feet with which he is to go about doing good." Actions such as feeding the hungry, giving drink to the thirsty, sheltering the homeless, visiting the sick and burying the dead are all actions that extend God's compassion and mercy.

The scriptural basis for the works of mercy are laid out in Matthew 25 when Jesus reminds us that when we feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, visit the sick and imprisoned, we are doing it for HIM. The works of mercy are not optional but rather essential to living the Christian life of holiness and goodness. We are not only to receive the mercy of God but to use it by being merciful to others through our actions. —Anne Ayella, Diocesan Director, Catholic Relief Services

Here are all seven: Feed the hungry; Give drink to the thirsty; Clothe the naked; Shelter the homeless; Visit the sick; Visit the imprisoned; Bury the dead.
