MOVING:

BAPTISMS:

Baptism is celebrated on the First and Third Saturdays of each month. Parents are required to complete the Baptism preparation program prior to scheduling the Baptism. An interview with the Parish Services Coordinator or one of the Parish Priests is necessary before beginning the Baptism sessions.

MARRIAGES:

Archdiocesan Regulations require that notice of intended marriage be made six months prior to the date of the marriage. Pre-nuptial instructions are required for marriage. Contact the Rectory for location.

CARE OF THE SICK:

Communion to the sick and Anointing of the Sick will be given upon request of someone who is ill, having surgery, or preparing for death. Emergency sick calls for the dying may be made at any time.

The Festival of Lessons and Carols is a service of Scripture and song that dates to the late 19th century. In this service, we listen to Scripture lessons which recount the fall of Adam and Eve, the promise of a Messiah, the Incarnation, and the Great Commission to preach the Good News. Each lesson is followed by a song that reflects on the lesson's message. **Queen's 4th Annual Advent Lessons and Carols Service** will be held on **Wednesday, December 2nd at 7pm in church.** In preparation for the great feast of Christ's incarnation, come gather to hear the poetry of the ancient prophets and listen to the story of Christ's coming retold through Scripture and song! Refreshments will be served in the Parish Center following the service.

ADVENT REFLECTION

Have you noticed? The commercials have started. The controversy over certain red cups has blown up social media. Industrious neighbors have already begun the process of putting up lights. It's obvious that the world's Christmas season is upon us.

The odd thing about this is that the Church's Christmas season doesn't begin until December 24th (followed by the - you guessed it -12 Days of Christmas). Up until then, we are in the season of Advent. It is a special time for preparing for the arrival of our Lord upon Earth. I like to challenge myself every year to make Advent significant, as I feel it can get glossed over with all of the Christmas merriment taking place long before the actual day arrives.

There are several opportunities for us to embrace Advent in its own wonderment and excited expectation for our Lord's arrival. There are the "Blue Books", given out by the parish, full of prayers and reflections for each day of Advent. One could use an Advent Calendar to mark the occasion. Get a small statue or a picture of the Holy Family and move them from spot to spot in your house, "Elf on the Shelf" style, having them eventually arriving at the manger on Christmas Eve. **There is also a wonderful Lessons and Carols event here on Wednesday, December 2nd, that doesn't concentrate on "Christmas Carols" but on songs and readings of expectation and preparation.** Christmas can be all the more wonderful and fulfilling, if the time is taken to properly set the spiritual stage for its celebration.

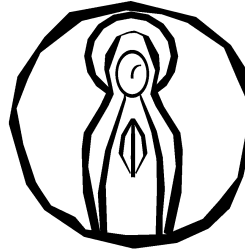

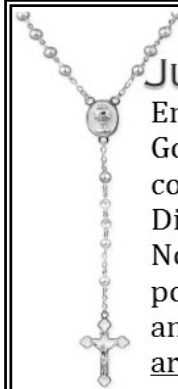
