MOVING:

If you are moving out of the parish, please notify the Rectory immediately so that we may discontinue your envelope mailings.

BAPTISMS:

Baptism is celebrated on the First and Third Saturdays of each month. Parents are required to complete the Baptism preparation program prior to scheduling the Baptism. An interview with the Parish Services Coordinator or one of the Parish Priests is necessary before beginning the Baptism sessions.

MARRIAGES:

Archdiocesan Regulations require that notice of intended marriage be made six months prior to the date of the marriage. Pre-nuptial instructions are required for marriage. Contact the Rectory for location.

CARE OF THE SICK:

Communion to the sick and Anointing of the Sick will be given upon request of someone who is ill, having surgery, or preparing for death. Emergency sick calls for the dying may be made at any time.

CROSS-TRAIN YOUR FAITH

Session Four covers the third and fourth periods on The Bible Timeline Chart: *Egypt and Exodus and Desert Wanderings*. At the close of the Patriarchs period, Jacobs's family has moved south to Egypt to escape famine. After some time has passed, a new pharaoh enslaves the Israelites. Jeff Cavins tells the story of how God liberates his people from bondage through his servant Moses. He also explains how the plagues are actually attacks on the false gods of the Egyptians and how God's signs and wonders reveal his sovereign power.

Following Israel's release from Egypt, God gives the people the Law and directions to build the Tabernacle, a place where his presence will rest among them. The children of Israel enter a kind of "boot camp" in the desert, during which God teaches them to trust him. Their failure leads to forty years of wandering in the desert until a new generation learns to walk in faith.

"**Cross Train Your Faith**" is part of the Adult Faith Formation Program here at Queen where we provide programs of study and present information of Catholic learning for the adults of Our Parish Family. All adults are invited to join us. There is no charge to participate, except if you want to purchase special study material available.

**The Jubilee Year of Mercy
December 8, 2015 through November 20, 2016**

The Holy Spirit, Fountain of Mercy

Mercy lies at the heart of the Christian faith. Catholics believe in a God of Mercy. He manifested His Mercy, first and foremost, in the Incarnation of his Word in the Person of Jesus Christ, who died on the cross for our sins. When he walked this earth, Jesus lived for others and greeted everyone he met with mercy and compassion. Mercy was the reason he entered this world. Mercy was why he forgave sins. Mercy was why he cured people of their physical ailments. Mercy was why he cast out demons. Mercy was why he suffered and died for us. Mercy for others was what he asked of his Father from the cross. Mercy was what flowed from his pierced side in the form of blood and water. Mercy was why he sent his Spirit to dwell in the hearts of the members of his body, the Church. Mercy was the reason for the sending of his Spirit at Pentecost.

The Holy Spirit is the Fountain of Mercy. He is the soul of the Church, the sacrament of Christ. He is invoked at the celebration of every sacrament. He is the source of Mercy, because he is the Bond of Love shared by the Father and the Son. From that Bond everything else flows: Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist, Reconciliation, Orders, Matrimony, Anointing. These sacraments give honor and glory to the Father. They are actions of Christ. They are the works of the Spirit. Through them we receive his manifold gifts and fruits. Holy Spirit, Fountain of Mercy, pray for us. – Rev. Dennis J. How to Live It

During the Holy Year of Mercy, begin the practice of invoking the Holy Spirit as soon as you wake up in the morning. Use the *Veni, Sancte Spiritus* or similar prayer to the Holy Spirit. Take note of the special daily mercies that result from this simple act of dependence on the Third Person of the Trinity.

Spirit of truth, you are the reward of the saints, the comforter of souls, light in the darkness, riches to the poor, treasure to lovers, food for the hungry, comfort to those who are wandering; to sum up, you are the one in whom all treasures are contained. Come! As you descended upon Mary that the Word might become flesh, work in us through grace as you worked in her through nature and grace. Come! Food of every chaste thought, fountain of all mercy, sum of all purity. Come! Consume in us whatever prevents us from being consumed in you."

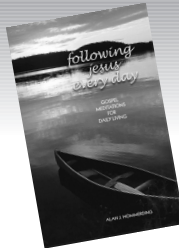
